**Vale Richard Pau (1938 – 2004)**

Richard Pau had an outstanding career as a scientist in the UK where he was born, and might

have been expected to retire after relocating to Australia with his wife Jaynie Anderson when she was appointed to the Chair of Fine Arts at Melbourne University. Instead, Richard took an honorary position within the Department of Biochemistry at Melbourne University where he collaborated on a variety of research projects, continued to publish in leading scientific journals, and played an invaluable role in the scientific mentoring of PhD students. A celebration of his life was held at Trinity College Chapel on 27 February.
